- Chaperones & Drivers *Throughout Season*  
Help supervise students at shows throughout the season. Parents ride the drumline bus with students to & from competitions. Drivers are needed to help drive the drumline equipment truck to & from competitions. No special licensure is required.
- Uniforms *Throughout Season*  
Parents are needed to help make drumline uniforms (measuring, sewing, cutting, etc.). Assistance with repairs as necessary. craftsman.
- Advertising Coordinator for Home Show Program  
An enthusiastic individual to coordinate parents & student activity to solicit ads for our home show program. This is an important source of income necessary to sustain our program. Previous advertisers spreadsheet and info is available.
- Concessions *Home Show*  
One main coordinator and many others are needed to staff concessions throughout the Home Show.
- Judges' Room *Home Show*  
Are you a Party Planner? Help provide a welcoming environment for visiting instructors & judges by decorating and coordinating refreshments for the judges' lounge throughout the day.
- Trophies *Home Show*  
Help produce the awards that will be handed out at the end of the show. Perfect for someone who's crafty or a craftsman.
- Raffle Prizes & People's Choice Coordinator *Home Show*  
Coordinate donations, prepare for raffle, & award raffle prizes. Also coordinate people's choice award for the Home Show.
- Entrance Staff/Ticket Sellers *Home Show*  
Sell tickets and handout programs.
- Team Ambassadors, Greeters, Roamers *Home Show*  
One coordinator and multiple staff to welcome and accompany visiting teams throughout event. Also provides general direction for all visitors.
- Score Keeper/Tabulator/Judge Runner Coordinator *Home Show*  
Records judge's scores for visiting drumline to an Excel document during show. Documents are provided. Judge runners, 1 for each judge – carries tapes, notes and scores from judge to score table. Helps assemble critique packets, forms, etc. Can be younger siblings/students.
- Gym Door Monitor *Home Show*  
Monitor gym doors before & after performances. Can be younger siblings/students.
- Announcer *Home Show*  
MC to welcome, announce lines, read bios, thank sponsors, and provide commentary throughout show.
- Producers *Home Show*  
Helps monitor the coordination and timing of the home show performances. Responsible for overall coordination of event.
- Parking/BAC Logistics *Home Show*  
One Coordinator and multiple staff to direct arrival of visiting drumlines to Bison Activity Center and correct doors for unloading/loading equipment.
- Senior Gifts *Home Show*  
Helps coordinate small gifts to be given to Senior during awards ceremony.
- Sign Coordinator *Home Show*  
Works with drumline to create signs for visiting lines, print promotional posters, and post throughout schools and the community.
